“Leadership–The Art of Empowerment” by Fr. Keith Clark and Mike Panther

Fr. Keith Clark is a Catholic priest of the Capuchin Order. He completed his postgraduate study at Oxford University in England and holds a Master’s degree in religious education from Fordham University in New York. He has dedicated much of his research and educational efforts to the study of leadership. He teaches, has had several publications in the area of servant leadership, and has held various leadership positions throughout his career.

Mike Panther is a retired executive with over 35 years of experience leading organizations primarily in manufacturing and operations roles. Mike earned a Bachelor’s degree from Purdue University and his Master’s degree in Business Management from Central Michigan. His leadership experience ranges from supervising groups as small as four to managing multiple manufacturing plants with thousands of employees. He has led the transformation of two major operations from bottom line losses to significant profitability and helped many colleagues achieve their own successful careers.

The two authors were introduced by Mike’s brother-in-law who is Treasurer for the Capuchin Province of which Fr. Keith is a member. As they talked and learned more about each other’s background, they found that they possessed similar views on leadership. They soon discovered that each of them had independently

been working on a book about leadership but neither had fully completed their work. In spite of their varied backgrounds both had come to the same conclusion as to what it takes to be a successful leader. The idea of combining their work intrigued them so a partnership was born.

The book presents, at least, three original concepts. First, the distinctions between manipulation, intimidation and leadership are carefully delineated. Second, the difference between leadership positions and leadership behaviors is explained. Third, a tool by which a leader can manage their own inner world and thus connect with colleagues rather than collide with them is demonstrated. There are also practical exercises that readers can do to improve their leadership skills.

The principles presented in their book have worked in both the nonprofit and for profit business segments. Mike and Fr. Keith share many personal experiences that buttress the effectiveness of their concepts and principles regarding servant leadership. To learn more about their uniquely Christian approach to leadership or to buy a copy of their book, Mike Panther will be the featured speaker at the next Catholic Business Breakfast on Wednesday, September 29 at 7 am at the Thornblade Clubhouse in Greer. He will be available to sign books after his presentation.
