## Fertility Care Conference coming to Upstate

The 29<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of the American Academy of Fertility Care Professionals will be held at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Greenville, South Carolina on Wednesday, July 21 through Saturday, July 24. Jointly sponsored by AAFCP and Creighton University School of Medicine, this meeting's theme is "Fertility Care: Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Truth."

Dr. Thomas Hilgers, director of the Pope Paul VI Institute for the Study of Human Reproduction and the National Center for Women's Health in Omaha, Nebraska, will be one of the featured speakers. Working at the St. Louis University and Creighton University Schools of Medicine, Hilgers and his coworkers developed the Creighton Model FertilityCare System.

The system allows a woman to unravel the mysteries of the menstrual and fertility cycle. It relies upon the standardized observation and charting of biological markers that are essential to a woman's health and fertility. These 'biomarkers' tell the couple when they are naturally fertile and infertile, allowing the couple to use the system either to achieve or postpone pregnancy. These biomarkers also telegraph abnormalities in a woman's health and are the basis for the new women's health science, NaPro Technology (natural procreative

technology). A woman can now know her cycles and use this information for the maintenance of her health, and couples can use this knowledge to build their future as a couple.

Dr. Hilgers is currently a senior medical consultant in obstetrics, gynecology, and reproductive medicine and surgery at the Pope Paul VI Institute. He is a clinical professor in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Creighton University School of Medicine, Omaha, Nebraska.

In 1994, Dr. Hilgers was appointed to permanent membership to the Pontifical Academy for Life. In 2004, Dr. Hilgers published the definitive textbook on natural procreative technology, *The Medical and Surgical Practice of NaProTECHNOLOGY*.

Other conference speakers include: Art Bennett, Director of Alpha Omega Clinics, Dr. Phil Boyle, a full time Fertility Care Physician, Dr. Paul Carpentier, President of His Image Family Medicine, Brenda Cercez, Executive Director of Family Honor, Fr.
