## Catholic Organizations Broadcasting in South Carolina

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has issued low power (LP) licenses to the following Catholic organizations broadcasting religious content:

- Charleston, SC - Blessed Sacrament Catholic School – WMHE-LP 102.9 FM
- Columbia, SC (east side) - St. Joseph's Catholic School – WZJO-LP 90.9 FM
- Columbia, SC (west side) - St. Peter's Catholic School – WROP-LP 92.7 FM
- Florence, SC - Columbus Club of Florence (Knights of Columbus) – WFOC-LP 93.3 FM
- Greenville, SC (Simpsonville/Mauldin SC area located at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church) - Monsignor Andrew K. Gwynn (Knights of Columbus) – WGUY-LP 107.7 FM
- Ridgeland/Bluffton/Hilton Head, SC - John Paul II Catholic School - WXJP-LP 94.9 FM
- Spartanburg, SC - St. Paul the Apostle Catholic School – WSEJ-LP 96.7 FM

## What is Low Power FM Radio?

Low Power FM (LPFM) radio service was created by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) in January 2000. LPFM stations are authorized for noncommercial, educational broadcasting only and operate with an effective radiated power of 100 watts or less. The approximate service range of a 100 watt station is 5.6 kilometers but can extend out to as much as a ten miles from the signal source under the right circumstances. By FCC rule, LPFMs aren't protected from interference by other classes of FM stations.
