Fr. Smolenski Leads Retreat on October 15

A native of New Haven, Connecticut and a priest of the Archdiocese of Hartford, Fr. Stanley Smolenski, spma, earned his degrees in philosophy and theology from American and Canadian colleges and universities. His post-ordination studies in spirituality were done in Rome. His various ministries included parishes, youth, the sick and handicapped, retreats, seminary professor, pilgrimage director, lecturer and author. Of his many years as a priest, 25 were spent at St. Martha parish in Enfield, CT. For the past ten years he has been involved in Eucharistic Evangelization in the Diocese of Charleston. He helped to found the Shrine of Our Lady of South Carolina – Mother of Joyful Hope – in Kingstree, SC. Now a Baptistine canonical hermit, his ministry as director of the Shrine is typically reserved for the pilgrims who visit.

Fr. Smolenski's connection to the Diocese of Charleston began many years ago. Prior to the priesthood, he assisted Fr. Patrick Walsh, OP, with his parish mission work in and around Kingstree. Fr. Walsh originated a church-on-wheels apostolate to introduce the Church to the public, especially in areas where there were no Catholics. He would open his mini-church in the center of small towns and invite people to see what a Catholic Church actually looked like with its altar, pews, stained glass windows and confessional. At that time, Fr. Smolenski was a brother in the same religious order as Fr. Walsh. After eighteen months, Fr. Stan decided to study for the priesthood. Providentially, he is back in Kingstree as a priest promoting the Marian and Eucharistic spirituality of Blessed John Paul II at the diocesan Shrine to Our Lady.
