

Kingstree, SC - The Shrine of Our Lady of South Carolina - Our Lady of Joyful Hope is the fulfillment of Fr. Stan Smolenski's request that the Diocese of Charleston be entrusted/consecrated to Our Lady and that an icon be commissioned. The icon was first shown to the public in Lexington, SC on October 5, 2003. Ever since, Fr. Smolenski has faithfully promulgated the devotion. For the 2019 Radiothon, the theme will be "Our Lady of Joyful Hope," to bring attention to the Shrine in Kingstree, SC. Donating After the "Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017"

The increase in standard deduction might dis-incentivize donors who can no longer receive a tax deduction for charitable giving. There are three means through which the donor can benefit: 1) Qualified Charitable Distributions from an Individual Retirement Account (IRA). Donors, 70.5 years or older, may distribute up to \$100,000 per year, including their Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), directly to a nonprofit and avoid taxes on the distribution. 2) Set up a Donor Advised Fund (DAF) where a donor can make a charitable contribution, immediately receive eligible tax deductions and then distribute donations to one or multiple nonprofits of their choice in any time frame. A donor can contribute multiple years of charitable giving in one year to surpass the itemization threshold, and in off-years take the standard deduction. 3) Make non-cash donations such as stocks, real estate or other assets. This can be particularly advantageous when the donation is an appreciated asset that has been owned for one-year or longer. In this case, the donor is able to receive a tax deduction for the entire value of the asset while avoiding long-term capital gains from its sale.
