WLTQ's New Companion, 106.7 FM

Charleston, SC - Catholic Radio in South Carolina has completed construction on an FM translator (repeater signal) at the WLTQ-AM site in Charleston. Call sign, W294CJ is available at 106.7 FM and will permanently serve the Charleston area. Of course, the AM signal (730) will remain available as well.

Mass Every Day at 8:00 a.m.

Catholic Radio in South Carolina offers the Live EWTN audio presentation of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass each day beginning at 8:00 a.m. on 730 AM, 1300 AM, and the rest of our audio platforms. At very least, listening to this Mass is a means of preparing for the Mass you plan to attend. For example, you'll already be familiar with the readings and any special prayers for that day.

Recently, with many churches required to cancel masses due to the Covid-19 virus... Catholic Radio in South Carolina continued to offer listeners an imperfect, but readily available, alternative. While these broadcasts are not intended to replace or fulfill a Sunday obligation, given the dispensation from that obligation whenever serious health issues arise, it may be helpful to listen to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass as a means to participate in spirit.

Catholic Content on LPFM Radio in SC

Low Power FM (LPFM) radio service was created by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) in January 2000. LPFM stations are authorized for noncommercial, educational broadcasting only and operate with an effective radiated power of 100 watts or less. The approximate service range of a 100 watt station is 5.6 kilometers but can extend out to as much as ten miles from the signal source. In 2019, the following stations were granted license renewal:

- Columbia (east side) - St. Joseph's Catholic School – WZJO-LP 90.9 FM
- Columbia (west side) - St. Peter's Catholic School – WRQP-LP 92.7 FM
- Daniel Island/Mount Pleasant – Bishop England High School – WBEI-LP 102.9 FM (MOVING)
- Florence - Columbus Club of Florence (Knights of Columbus) – WFOC-LP 93.3 FM
- Greenville (Simpsonville/Mauldin area located at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church) - Monsignor Andrew K. Gwynn (Knights of Columbus) – WGWY-LP 107.7 FM
- Ridgeland/Bluffton/Hilton Head - John Paul II Catholic School - WXJP-LP 94.9 FM
- Spartanburg - St. Paul the Apostle Catholic School – WSEJ-LP 96.7 FM

For standard cell phones or landlines: Just dial **NEW NUMBER 1** (605) 313-0891 (Powered by Zeno Media®), and your phone becomes a personal Catholic Radio listening device. There is no extra charge for this service but your normal call rates and limits do apply. Many plans have unlimited long distance or calling, so you can listen essentially for free. Check your calling plan to be sure.

Use TuneIn® Radio App for smart phones and special applications: Whether it's smartphones, tablets, digital radios or smart TVs, the TuneIn® Radio App allows you to listen to us. Download the free app from your phone's app store. Then perform a station search by typing "WCKI" in the App's search engine and our logo will pop up. Click on it and you'll be able to listen to our streaming audio.

Donating After “Tax Cuts & Jobs Act of 2017”

There are three means through which a donor can benefit from changes in tax law:

- 1) Qualified Charitable Distributions from an Individual Retirement Account (IRA). Donors, 70.5 years or older, may distribute up to \$100,000 per year, including their Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), directly to a nonprofit and avoid taxes on the distribution.
- 2) Individuals and Families can set up a Donor Advised Fund (DAF) where a donor can make a charitable contribution, immediately receive eligible tax deductions and then distribute donations to one or multiple nonprofits of their choice in any time frame. A donor can contribute multiple years of charitable giving in one year to surpass the itemization threshold, and in off-years take the standard deduction.
- 3) Make non-cash donations such as stocks, real estate or other assets. This can be particularly advantageous when the donation is an appreciated asset that has been owned for one-year or longer. In this case, the donor is able to receive a tax deduction for the entire value of the asset while avoiding long-term capital gains from its sale. Of course, you can always remember Catholic Radio in your Will.
